- i. Comsenr Steinberg resolution re "No Wake Zone" for entirety of Intracoastal Waterway
 - 1. Amended in committee to start at McArthur Causeway to County line - Adopted in committee.
- ii. BASF Working group provided additional comments to DERM staff.
- iii. BASF members to monitor issue FI Fish & Wildlife Service also involved.

IV. Solid Waste Master Plan – Solid Waste Director Ms. Olga Espinosa-Anderson will be April 19 Legislative Special Guest - update by participating Members and staff.

- i. Using private haulers, County estimates about 12 years' capacity left;
 - 1. Working on consultant to prepare RFP for new waste to energy plant.
 - 2. "Trash trains that may handle sludge and recycling -could be an option.
- ii. Final location: still pending based on air quality modeling.
- iii. Possibly early March look for site

 - 2. Likely final draft: late March / early April to BCC for First Reading.
 - d. Wetlands Banking Participating Members and staff to report:
 - i. Discuss meeting with DERM staff re mitigation options at existing County EEL lands, with proper financial assurance statement - Members could assist with form of legal template....
